Criteria for Gamma Gamma Boule' Foundation Scholarship - 2015

Gamma Gamma Boule's Social Action Committee will select the recipient(s) for the Boule' Scholarship. The scholarship award is in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00). The scholarship will be paid directly to the student upon verification by his accredited college/university that he is enrolled as a full-time student, carrying a minimum of 12 semester hours.

To qualify for the scholarship, the student must:

Be an African-American male high school senior enrolled in a metropolitan Austin or greater Waco area high school on a full time basis, and intend to attend a four-year college or university upon graduation.

Have attained a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0/4.0

Demonstrate leadership potential and good-citizenship along with community involvement and /or service.

Provide a one page biographical sketch explaining why he wants to attend college

Provide a letter of recommendation from one of his teachers, a counselor, or his principal.

Provide a copy of his transcript.

Properly complete the application form provided.

Submit the completed application, with narrative, letter, and transcript to the address below, in time to be received not later than Monday, May 4, 2015.
